- 1891 Jan. 30 Levi Stewart Udall born at noon to Eliza Luella
Stewart and David King Udall in St. Johns, Az.
June 4 Levi blessed by Eric Larson
- 1893 Mar. 30 Louise Lee born to Inez Hamblin and John David Lee
in Luna, New Mexico
July 6 Louise blessed by John David Lee
- 1896 Sept. Levi commenced school in Eagar, Az.
- 1899 Feb. 11 Levi baptized by Heber Jarvis in Eagar, Az.
Levi confirmed by E. N. Freeman
Sept. Louise commenced school in Luna, New Mexico
- 1900 Sept. Louise with her family moved to Thatcher, Az.
- 1902 Apr. 5 Louise baptized by John Allen in Thatcher, Az.
Apr. 6 Louise confirmed by Frank Tyler in Thatcher, Az.
- 1903 Jan. 22 Levi ordained a Deacon in St. Johns, Az.
- 1905 April Levi graduated from 8th grade, St. Johns, Az.
- 1907 Jan. 7 Levi ordained a Teacher in St. Johns, Az.
Apr. 26 Louise graduated from 8th grade, Thatcher, Az.
- 1907-1909 Levi farmed with his father, drove mail with team
and buckboard between Holbrook and St. Johns,
and graduated from the St. Johns Academy (10th grade)
- 1909 Feb. 8 Levi ordained a Priest in St. Johns, Az.
Sep. 13 Levi and his brother John H. arrived in Thatcher
to enrol in St. Joseph Academy for two years.
They drove a buckboard from St. Johns.
Levi and Louise meet as students at St. Joseph
Academy
- 1910 Aug. 28 Levi ordained an Elder in St. Johns, Az.
Sept. Levi goes to Los Angeles for osteopathic treatment
for dislocated ribs. Lives with Pearl and
attends Polytechnic High School

- 1911 Jan. Levi returns to Thatcher to continue school
- Apr. 21 Levi and Louise graduate in a class of 4 boys and 10 girls from St. Joseph Stake Academy
- Levi helps with construction of Udall home in St. Johns
- Sept. Louise teaches 2d grade in Pima, Az. at \$70 per month
- Louise serves as Secretary to St. Joseph Stake Sunday School Board
- 1912 June Louise goes to Flagstaff to attend Northern Arizona Normal School
- Sept. Levi goes to Tucson to attend University of Arizona on an agricultural scholarship of \$125
- 1913 Levi helps organize S.A.E. Fraternity on U of A Campus in Tucson
- May Levi returns to St. Johns to work with his father
- May 13 Louise graduates from Northern Arizona Normal School with a teaching certificate for life
- Sept. Louise again teaches in Pima, Az. with a \$5 raise
- 1914 Jan. Levi goes to Tucson for a month for nose surgery
- May Louise finishes teaching and prepares for her wedding
- June 14 Levi and Louise are endowed and married in Salt Lake Temple and return to St. Johns to live in the family home with his parents. Levi continues farming
- Aug. 23 Levi ordained a Seventy by Joseph McMurrin in St. Johns
- Nov. Levi and John H. run for Clerk of the Superior Court. Levi loses by one vote
- 1915 Jan. Levi appointed Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and serves until 1918
- Levi and Louise move into the Air Castle (ramshackle pioneer wooden house which admitted the winter winds)
- Nov. 28 Inez born in Air Castle

- 1916 Levi elected Trustee of School Dist. #11 (1916-20)
- 1917/18 Louise serves as St. Johns Ward YWMIA President
- 1917 Dec. 23 Elma born in Air Castle
- 1918 Levi elected Clerk of Superior Court of Apache County (1919-1922)
- 1919 Levi begins 3-year correspondence course in Law from LaSalle University in Chicago (lessons due weekly)
- Louise serves as Primary song leader and teacher for several years
- 1920 Jan. 31 Stewart Lee born in Air Castle
- July Levi set apart by D. K. Udall as Alternate High Counselor
- Levi goes as Az. delegate to Democratic National Convention in San Francisco
- Levi and Louise start Apache Abstract Company (1920-1946)
- 1921 Levi serves as Secretary of St. Johns High School Board (1921-1930)
- Apr. Levi set apart as Stake Supt. of YMMIA by Adam S. Bennion
- 1922 Apr. 30 Levi set apart and sustained as Stake President of St. Johns Stake by Apostle Rudger Clawson (youngest Stake President in Church by 5 years)
- May 6 Admitted to Arizona State Bar (second place in bar exam)
- May 22 Louise's father John David Lee dies in Thatcher
- June 15 Morris King born in new house
- Nov. Levi elected County Attorney of Apache County (serves 1923-24 and 1927-28)
- 1924 Nov. 14 Eloise born
- Levi begins teaching Gospel Doctrine class in Sunday School--continues intermittently for 25 years

- 1928 Aug. Louise completes correspondence course in speed writing
Louise serves on YWMIA Stake Board and later becomes President--specializes in pageants and 3-act plays
- 1929 Jan. 20 David Burr born (on his Father's birthday)
Levi begins 30 years of service with Boy Scouts of America--Vice President of Roosevelt Council, President of Grand Canyon Council, and also on Executive Board of each
- 1930 Nov. 4 Levi elected Judge of Apache County Superior Court (1931-1946). He defeated the incumbent, Judge Andrew S. Gibbons, 847 to 596. Judge Gibbons was his friend and mentor, having helped Levi study his law correspondence courses.
- 1932 Louise begins teaching 15-16 year olds in Sunday School (released in 1945)
- 1933 Mar. 4 Louise's mother, Inez Hamblin Lee, dies in Thatcher
- 1934 Nov. 11 Louise's brother Rex Lee killed in Kaibab Forest
- 1937 May 24 Levi's mother, Eliza Luella Stewart Udall, dies in St. Johns
- 1938 Feb. 18 Levi's father, David King Udall, dies in St. Johns
- 1940 June 1 Inez marries Eugene T. Turley in St. Johns. Levi performs the ceremony
- 1941 Mar. Levi begins trying the Train Limit case (State of Ariz. v. Southern Pacific) in Tucson. This was a constitutional law case of national significance, Levi finding for the defendant. The Arizona Supreme Court reversed his decision in Dec. 1943 but the U.S. Supreme Court unanimously affirmed it in 1945.
- 1941-45 Louise serves as co-chairman of Apache County American Red Cross Chapter
Levi serves as Apache County Chairman of War Loan Drives and Civilian Defense
Stewart, Morris, Elma and Gene Turley (Inez's husband) all serve in World War II
Burr enlists in 1946 and serves in the army of occupation in the Philippines
- 1943 Oct. 10 Louise Turley born to Inez and Gene in Tucson

- 1945 Sep. 9 Levi released as Stake President by Apostle Ezra Taft Benson
- Nov. 1 Louise released as Stake YWMIA President
- 1946 Jan. 21 Louise becomes a member of the Daughters of the Utah Pioneers
- May 21 Kent Eugene Turley born to Inez and Gene in Long Beach, Ca.
- Aug. 24 Eloise marries Warren G. Whiting in St. Johns. Levi performs the ceremony
- Nov. 5 Levi elected Justice of Arizona Supreme Court (re-elected 1952 & 1958). He defeated the incumbent, Joseph H. Morgan, in the Primary Election by 3150 votes (52%).
- 1947 Jan. 1 Levi and Louise move to Phoenix, Az.
- Jan. 2 Levi pioneers use of law clerks on Supreme Court
- Aug. 1 Stewart marries Ermalee Webb in Mesa, Az. Levi performs the ceremony.
- 1948 May 18 Thomas Stewart Udall born to Lee and Stewart in Tucson
- Levi authors the Supreme Court opinion which reversed a prior decision and gave the Indians the right to vote in Arizona
- 1949 Jun 15 Morris marries Patricia Emery in Lordsburg, NMex
- May 15 Scott Sterling Udall born to Stewart and Lee in Tucson
- Aug. 24 Margaret Lee Turley born to Inez and Gene in Santa Cruz, Ca.
- Nov. 25 Bruce Raymond Whiting born to Eloise and Warren in Pasadena, Ca.
- 1950 Mar. Louise begins working with Indians as Relief Society counselor for Maricopa Branch
- Apr. Levi and Louise commissioned by his family to collaborate in editing the book begun by David K. Udall and Pearl about his life. Spent five summers working on it.

- 1950 Jul. 18 Mark Emery Udall born to Pat and Morris in Tucson
- Sep. 29 Gail Turley and Mark Ernest Turley born to Inez and Gene in Santa Cruz, Ca.
- Nov. 26 Lynn Udall born to Lee and Stewart in Tucson
- 1951 Levi becomes a charter member of Phoenix National Council of Christians and Jews representing LDS Church. Was twice elected Chairman of National Brotherhood Week.
- Mar. Louise becomes Relief Society President of Maricopa Indian Branch
- Oct. 29 James Randolph Udall born to Pat and Morris in Tucson
- Nov. 18 Colleen Whiting born to Eloise and Warren in Phoenix
- 1952 Nov. 21 Lori Udall born to Lee and Stewart in Tucson
- Dec. 22 Judith King Udall born to Pat and Morris in Tucson
- 1953 Dec. 4 Helen Turley and Christopher Wilson Turley born to Inez and Gene in Lima, Peru
- Dec. 8 Marilyn Whiting born to Eloise and Warren in Phoenix
- 1954 Jul. 5 Anne Jeanette Udall born to Pat and Morris in Tucson
- Levi twice goes to Valley Forge as a jury member of Freedom Foundation Awards
- 1955 Jan. 15 David Burr marries Alice Elizabeth Allington in Tucson. Levi performs the ceremony
- 1956 Jun. 15 Denis Maxwell Udall born to Lee and Stewart in McLean, Va.
- Jul. 19 Douglas Lee Whiting born to Eloise and Warren in Richmond, Va.
- 1957 Apr. 21 Linda Marie Udall born to Alice and Burr in Tucson
- Apr. 28 Bradley Hunt Udall born to Pat and Morris in Tucson
- 1958 Jan. 19 Levi installed as Patriarch of new North Phoenix Stake by Apostle Delbert L. Stapley
- Feb. 9 Louise released (with tears) as Relief Society President of Maricopa Indian Branch
- Jul. 18 Laura Elizabeth Udall born to Alice and Burr in Tucson

- 1959 Arizona Pioneer Mormon published
- Jan. 26 Katherine Lee Udall born to Pat and Morris in Tucson
- May 20 James David Udall born to Lee and Stewart in McLean, Va.
- Nov. 21 Levi awarded Medallion of Merit from the University of Arizona
- 1960 Jan. THIS IS YOUR LIFE presented for Levi by the North Phoenix Stake M.I.A.
- Feb. Levi is awarded the Silver Beaver by the Boy Scouts of America
- Mar. 1 Levi presented with Doctor of Laws Degree from the University of Arizona
- May 30 Levi dies in Wickenburg, Az.
- Jun. 2 Levi buried in Phoenix, Az.
- 1961 Jun. 5 Karen Whiting born to Eloise and Warren in Richmond, Va.
- 1965 Inez and Gene are divorced
- 1966 Jan. 10 Morris and Pat are divorced
- 1968 Dec. 1 Morris marries Ella Royston
- Dec. 20 Kent Turley marries Nancy Freestone in Mesa, Az.
- 1969 ME AND MINE - the Life Story of Helen Sekaquaptewa, written by Louise and published by U of A Press
- 1970 Sep. 18 Louise Turley marries Ian Neale in Salt Lake City
- 1971 Aug. 25 Harry Stuart Neale born to Louise and Ian

- 1973 Jul. 27 Mark Turley marries Lynne Slater in Mesa, Az.

- Feb. 15 Louise buried beside Levi in Phoenix, Az.
